
DRAIN VALVE - REPLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS



CAUTION: SERVICING

- DISCONNECT MAIN POWER SOURCE BEFORE ACCESSING INTERNAL COMPARTMENTS.
- THE PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL COMPARTMENTS CONTAIN HIGH VOLTAGE COMPONENTS AND WIRING. ACCESS SHOULD BE LIMITED TO AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY.

2. Turn off the unit when the cylinder is empty.

- 3. Disconnect power to the unit.
- 4. Remove cylinder.
- 5. Disconnect spade terminals from the drain valve.
- 6. Remove the screw holding the green ground wire and the two screws holding he valve to the drain pan.
- 7. Squeeze the tabs of the spring clamp holding the hose to the drain valve and slide it up the hose. Pull hose from drain valve.
- 8. Drain valve can be removed and replaced with new one.
- 9. Reverse steps above to install drain valve.

Note:

- a) Replacement hose clamp and screws are provided, if required. The shorter 3/4" long screws are the for Residential Humidifier series, (RH. RH2, RH2+). The longer screw is for all other products.
- b) If replacement ground wire not required reconnect existing ground wire.
